
We have had a very busy 6 months having completed a number of projects, ranging from Land Speed Records to industrial working life and warhorses. Through this time we have developed our expertise and skill levels by creating our own interactive software solutions which have included animation. ### Recent Work

Over the last 18 months we have continued with the National Motor Museum, Beaulieu, Masterplan plus completing new projects at the Tank Museum and Mansfield Museum.

### Land Speed Record

An immersive audio visual experience, which presents via a dual sided projection the story of the Land Speed Record. A film is projected over the key vehicle exhibits which form part of the show. At strategic moments the 'key' exhibits are highlighted and brought to life via archive film, new footage and sound effects. Giving the visitors a sense of the experience of the men behind the wheel where they were risking life and limb. Integrated into the story are the 'team' and 'personalities' behind these amazing feats of speed and daring.



### Made in Mansfield

The story of industrial development in the town of Mansfield. Through a variety of media the sight, smell and products of the town are brought to life via this multi-layered experience. Enabling the visitor to interact and discover what working life was like.



### Warhorse

Working closely with the client team and consulting with a variety of user groups from families to disability access groups, a gallery was created to illustrate the transition of the British Army from horse power to mechanisation primarily in World War 1. The intention was to tell this dramatic and fast moving story through the imaginary perspective of the horses. To achieve this we created sculptural horses with concealed audio, activated by PIR sensors as visitors passed providing an engaging and surprising experience.

### Coming Up

#### Chawton House

Far Post Design have been commissioned by Chawton House and Library to develop a new display within the grand dining room and upper library due to be open in the Autumn.

#### Dam Busters Raid

A new display to be added to the existing exhibition we created last year telling the story of the great WWII raid and Barnes Wallis bouncing bomb.

#### Beaulieu

Next stage development to include a new Technology & Innovation gallery telling the story of car design and production.

#### Haslemere Museum
